DISPATCHING CHECKLIST

Our energetic and service-oriented staff will be drafting a dispatching checklist very soon. This checklist will be posted next to each of the club computers, and will also be available as a resource on CCA's website. This way, you will be able to print it and place it next to your own home computer, or carry it with you for reference from any computer with Internet access.

NEW RENTAL RATES:

Due to the rising cost of fuel, and effective August 1, 2005, the rental rates of our fleet will be as follows:

Warrior	\$95 per hour (increase of \$6)
Arrow	\$119 per hour (increase of \$4)
Diamond	\$125 (no change)

These increases do not completely make up for the rise in fuel costs. In other words, to keep costs reasonable and our airplanes competitive, our owners are sharing the sharp fuel cost increases with those of us who fly their airplanes.

CLUB COMPUTERS

Remember that the computers in the CCA office are "community" computers, and that many people share in their use. Please do not attempt to make any changes in the configuration of the computers. This includes copying or deleting files, and installing new software.

If there is a computer program that you think would be worthwhile to have on the club's computers, please let our staff know, and our computer expert will install the software for the benefit of the entire club membership.

SECURITY

On September 1st we will begin quarterly changing of the pass code on the club's key locks (on the outside door, the inside door, and the airplane key locker). This is for the security of the club's property, including our airplanes. When the change occurs, look for an E-Mail from our Staff with the new code.



OPERATIONS NOTES

- If, while flying one of CCA's airplanes, you are involved in any kind of incident that causes any damage to the airplane, it is extremely important that you contact our Staff right away. This will help our planning, ensure the insurance process goes smoothly, and enable us to notify the airplane owner immediately.
